## **OPENING THE CLOSET IN THE LOCKER ROOM...**

The Intercom Trust's Community Development Team is very pleased to announce that funding has just been awarded to them to run a 6 month project on tackling homophobia in sport.

Community consultation carried out by Intercom and the LGBT Collective in Devon presented a large amount of feedback and concern over the increasingly publicised homophobia in Sport, especially within Football. As a community responsive origination we set about doing something about those concerns and made an application to Comic Relief, administered by Devon Community Foundation, which was successful and the new project has been awarded £6,942!!

This money will enable a Sports Education Outreach Officer to be employed on a part time basis to start tackling homophobia in Football on a local and county level in teams, schools and through community outreach work. The new Worker will be coordinating a working partnership with the local and regional teams and other relevant organisations to create a sustainable Devon Wide campaign that the communities and teams can continue into

the future, a campaign which could have real potential for positive influence over those who play the game and those who watch it.

We will soon be looking for someone to fill the role of the Sports Education Outreach Officer – so if you think this might be a job for you – watch this space or get in touch!
